
Mission





- Be communicative, responsive, and respectful







This funding opportunity aims to award up to \$50,000 for multiple projects to eligible entities with a demonstrated short-term need, less than six (6) months. The application is available year round, on an ongoing basis.

State of Colorado Purchase Order Terms and Conditions

- 1. Offer/Acceptance. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency within this PO, such conflict or inconsistency shall be resolved by giving preference to the documents in the following order of priority: (a) If applicable, Addendum 2: Additional Terms and Conditions for Federal Provisions, below; (b) the Purchase Order document; (c) these Terms and Conditions (including, if applicable, Addendum 1: Additional Terms and Conditions for Information Technology below); and (d) any attachments, exhibits, specifications, or appendices, whether attached or incorporated by reference. Any terms and conditions included on Vendor's forms or invoices not included in this PO are void.
- Safety Information. All chemicals, equipment, and materials proposed or used in the
 performance of this PO shall conform to the requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act
 of 1970. Vendor shall furnish all Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for any regulated chemicals,
 equipment, or hazardous materials at the time of delivery.


Request Technical Assistance

Submit a technical assistance inquiry to request support for project ideas related to a Capacity Building Grant or the STEPS program. For these projects, submitting an inquiry is required.


