WHAT IS TASP? (TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE SERVICE PROVIDER) PROGRAM



- Technical Assistance Service Provider
- Administered by CDPHE and the FRWD Board of Directors.
- Direct technical consulting support at ‘no cost’.
- Examples: zero waste planning, local and regional feasibility analysis, engagement and outreach design and support, local ordinances, stakeholder engagement, program planning, and many others.

HOW TASP CAN HELP

TASP directly assists local governments with increasing diversion and reducing waste

TASP helps:

- Plan, initiate, or optimize a locally appropriate program, policy, project
- Get accelerated access to FRWD funding
- Facilitate peer community learning

EXAMPLE OF POTENTIAL TASP PROJECTS:

- Recycling drop-off site evaluation and optimization
- Helping a city write a zero waste action plan
- Supporting data collection set-up with ReTrac or other tools
- Policy evaluations, recommendations, and implementation
- Waste composition studies
- Construction and demolition program option evaluation and implementation
- Facility feasibility assessment and planning (MRF, compost processing)
- Residential recycling program development and adoption
- Hauler licensing ordinance development and implementation
- Community engagement planning including implementation
- Commercial business recycling program evaluation, design, and implementation
- Pay-As-You-Throw assessment, rate study, and implementation support
